

# 2024 Tri-Country Baseball Tournament Rules

Games will be played under Tri-Country baseball rules as stated on website

A Tri-Country player can only play at one level no exceptions

A team can play with 8

Pinto can play with only 8 and not take an out

Mustang, Bronco, and Pony must take the out at 9 spot in lineup

Before game and coaches meeting umpires will inspect all bats

If an illegal bat is found it will be immediately removed from dugout

If an illegal bat is found during game

batter is out, ejected from game, as well as coach as per Tri-Country rules

All time limits will be in play

Games will be played till timer goes off  
umpire will declare time has expired finish the inning (if home team is batting and winning the game will be called)

If time expires between innings that inning will be played (the top of a new inning begins immediately after 3rd out of bottom of inning)

Time will begin after the coaches meeting before game

There will be no ties and a winner will be declared

Pace of play will be enforced

After first inning pitcher will be allowed 5 warm up pitches (4 pitches 5th going

down) Play Ball!

Umpires will enforce Pace of play throughout entire game (Pace for mound visits, Pace for getting in the box and so on at their discretion)

After 1st inning no warmup balls for infield or outfeild

A new pitcher entering game will be allowed 10 warmup pitches

After 2 outs a courtesy runner can be used for the catcher (last man out)

If coaches warmup pitcher those balls are counted and will result in catcher finishing number of pitches or throw down when on feild if pitcher threw 4 or 5

All winners will report scores, pitchers, and
